Macugnaga is a typical Italian mountain village with lots of charm, nestled at the foot of the awe inspiring Monte Rosa, Europe's second highest mountain. The picturesque village consists of two parts; Pecetto, the more peaceful part of town, next to the Belvedere ski area and Macugnaga centre (also called Staffa) with its alleyways full of shops, cafes and bars. The two areas are about 15 minutes apart and covered by one ski pass. There are some superb long runs with fresh powder and the uncrowded pistes give ample space for beginners to practice. The ski and snowboard school has an excellent reputation and is very welcoming to our British School groups.
