Killington Resort, the largest ski and snowboard resort in eastern North America known for long seasons thanks to abundant natural snowfall and the most extensive snowmaking system in the world, celebrates its 51st year of skiing and riding with the 2009-10 season. Killington's elevation advantage delivers an average of 250 inches of natural snow every season and optimal temperatures to produce machine-made snow, especially during November and December, with more than 1,400 snow guns covering 71 percent of the resort's 752 acres of skiing and riding terrain. For the 2009-10 season Killington resort continues to expand its environmental programs, including 100 percent offset of energy use through the purchase of Renewable Energy Credits (RECs) and a 15 percent increase in Low Energy Snow gun arsenal – the largest in the Northeast. Killington region activities, including dog sledding, cross country skiing, sleigh rides, snowshoeing, snowmobiling and ice skating, are combined with outstanding lodging values and numerous restaurants and bars, plus shopping options throughout the region.
